Please take note that there has been a change to the What To Bring List in regards to the Joshua Generation outreach uniform. We want to look the best that we can while ministering on the streets and in churches, so we are updating our wardrobe!

Girls:

We will be ordering **fitted shirts** instead of regular t-shirts. (If you would prefer a regular one for some reason, please call to speak with me.)



Under the t-shirts we will be wearing **long colored tank tops**. You will be responsible to purchase and bring at least 3 different bright colored ones. These can be purchased at Old Navy, Target, Gap, or other like stores.

Instead of khaki capris, we will be wearing **uniform black capris** during street ministry (have at least 2 pair). Old Navy also sells Yoga pants that would be adequate. (Not gauchos or workout style) The point is that we do not want the bottoms to be tight, form fitting, sloppy, or revealing at all and we do want for everyone to be uniform. The length should hit about right below the knee. A pair of **black long pants** should also be brought for church services. They should be trouser style and not form-fitting or sloppy.



Instead of white tennis shoes we will be wearing **black Mary-Jane style shoes**. These are very popular right now and can be found in many styles at many places. Sketchers has some styles as well as Target and Payless Shoes. You will be dancing in these shoes, so be sure that they are comfortable. Small socks (Ped brand) are good to wear with them. A pair of regular sneakers should still be brought for games and other activities.



Guys:

The dress will be the same for you as it has been in past years. **Khaki shorts** will be worn during street performances and **khaki pants** to church ministries. **Black sneakers** will be worn for all venues.

Also you should plan to bring a pair of black gym shorts for basketball or sports ministry times.
